

Check Out The Full world t20 schedule 2021

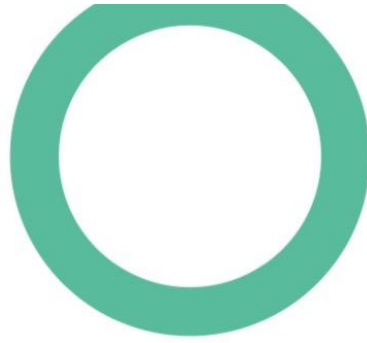
The final of the tournament is scheduled to take place on November 14 at the Dubai International Stadium in the United Arab Emirates
